General Terms and Conditions

- Vinmonopolet's Terms of Service (the "API Terms") describe your rights and responsibilities when accessing our publicly available application programming interfaces (the "APIs") and related API documentation. Please read them carefully.
- These Terms shall apply to any use of Vinmonopolet's APIs. As used in these Terms, "APIs" means programmatic web APIs, software and other functionality and their associated tools and documentation that Vinmonopolet makes available to you.
- These API Terms form a binding contract between you and Vinmonopolet.
- The API Terms does not grant you rights to use any other of our tools/platform/interfaces.
- Subject to the restrictions below, this API Terms grant you a non-exclusive, nontransferable limited license to access our APIs and documentation only as necessary to develop, test and support an integration of your applications with the Services.
- The information is provided through APIs by Vinmonopolet.
- Your network and the operating system and software of your servers, databases, and computer systems must be properly configured to securely operate your application and store data. Data must be stored and served using strong encryption.

Liability

- Vinmonopolet does not warrant the completeness, accuracy, reliability, suitability or availability of the information, products, services, or other related graphics contained in the API. Vinmonopolet is not to be held liable for a situation where the APIs are being temporarily unavailable due to technical issues or any other reason. Any reliance you place on information provided though Vinmonopolet's APIs is therefore strictly at your own risk.
- In no event will Vinmonopolet be liable for any loss or damage including, without limitation, indirect or consequential loss or damage, or any loss or damage whatsoever arising from loss of data or profits arising out of, or in connection with, the use of the APIs.

• Through the APIs, you might be able to link to information delivered by third parties which are not under the control of Vinmonopolet. Vinmonopolet takes no responsibility, and have no control over the nature, content and availability of this information.

Restrictions

- You may not sell, rent, lease, redistribute, or syndicate access to any of Vinmonopolet's APIs. API access and consequently from its use gained API data, is for your use only and access may not be shared with third parties, except for subcontractors who are part of Vinmonopolet's supply chain such as distributors and similar subcontractors.¹
- Applications and developers are also prohibited from:
 - degrading or compromising security in any way
